

Great Britain Experience 2009

The Engineering Link Group, in cooperation with the Smallpeice Trust of the United Kingdom, is offering four scholarships to be taken in the UK in July 2009. These scholarships are for a duration of approximately 2 weeks, and comprise of a week at the Smallpeice Trust's Engineering Management Skills course and approximately 7 days touring around London and the surrounding countryside.

The scholarship includes the following:

- An airfare (economy class) to London from your nearest major centre and return (valued at approximately \$2200)
- Full accommodation, meals and enrolment at the Engineering Management Skills course (valued at approximately \$600)



Cost to applicants: \$1000 (this covers accommodation while not at the course, some meals, transport in England, travel insurance). This amount is payable to TELG by February 2009. You will also need spending money (for some meals, souvenirs, entry fees to attractions etc)

Basic Itinerary:

- Leave Australia Early July 2009 (during Term 3)
- London – stay at St Paul's YHA – see all the sites of London and see a play at The Globe.
- Touring around southern England – see Stonehenge, Salisbury Cathedral and as many castles as we can find!
- Smallpeice Trust Design & Manufacture – University of Greenwich
- Return to Australia

Applications are invited from all students who attend one of the Engineering Link Projects (Rockhampton, Brisbane and Townsville) for the full four days. Intending scholars must address the following selection criteria, and return their completed application by **October 17th, 2009**.

Selection Criteria:

SC1: Why do YOU want to be an engineer?

SC2: What qualities and skills could YOU bring to engineering, and in particular the discipline you are interested in.

SC3: What benefits would this scholarship bring to YOUR career as an engineer (see <http://www.smallpeicetrust.org.uk>)?

What to include in your application (along with your responses to the Selection Criteria):

- Your contact details (full name, date of birth, address, email address, phone number(s))
- Your most recent School Report.
- A letter from your Principal supporting your application.

Some other details:

- Responses to the Selection Criteria should total no more than 3 A4 typed pages (1.5 line spacing)
- Successful scholars will be notified by mail by 31st October 2008
- Travel arrangements will be finalised by March 2009.
